FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION #3:

WHAT IS THE ROLE & FUNCTION OF THE "TECHNICAL COORDINATOR"?

ROLES

A Technical Coordinator may be assigned to a competitive team or an age division within the SUSC U10-18 age divisions. Each TC is responsible for four (4) critical roles;

- Analyze Team and Individual Performance
- Train the team
- Mentor the Technical Staff
- Coordinate player mobility between SUSC Teams

Each role is equally important to the development of the individual player, the team performance and the development of the Technical Staff.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The TC for a team is required to;

- Maintain direct contact with the team/coach. This contact may be; a Match analysis, Training analysis, Team Training or a planning and strategy session.
- Complete a written Technical Report on each match that is observed.
- Complete a season-end report that summarizes strengths and developmental areas of the age group.
- Complete a weekly CONTACT report as well as a weekly GUEST PLAYER report.
- Participate in bi-monthly Tech. Coordinator Meetings.
- Mentor the Team Technical Staff by sharing ideas, training plans and assessment of team and individual progress.

VALUE

The Technical Coordinator provides a valuable link between the Club Directors, the team technical staff and the individual athletes that we serve. The integration of written documentation, weekly reporting and weekly face-face dialogue provides the athlete with a strong network of support. The system also provides a mechanism for the Technical Staff to share our individual strengths with one another and thus enhance the experience for the athlete.
