SYSC COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Know the Laws of the Game and League Rules
 - a. MICRO – Club Rules (FIFA)
 - b. MOD - NCYSA (FIFA)
 - c. U11 and Up - NCYSA, WYS (FIFA)
2. Respect Referees
 - a. Do not question their decisions openly
 - b. If you disagree ask them politely to explain
 - c. **PARENTS AND SPECTATORS HAVE NO BUSINESS TALKING TO REFEREES – PERIOD**
3. Teach your team to play fair and within the rules.
4. Set a good example for your players, parents and spectators.
5. Respect all players, parents and opponents. Never ridicule or embarrass anyone.
6. Control your players, parents and sideline spectators. You are responsible for their behavior on the field and during the game.
7. Support all facets of the Snohomish Youth Soccer Club.
8. Remember that in away games you are our ambassador so set an extra good example.

As a coach you are personally responsible and liable for any player playing soccer that has not been registered with Snohomish Youth Soccer Club (So make sure all your players are registered.)
